Teacher Notes

Lesson focus

Students will be asked to:

- review an information sheet to identify fact and opinion
- complete a crossword
- select appropriate images to be included in a poster
- identify appropriate signs to display

Glossary words

These are found in the podcast:

Fact, opinion, image, key phrases, silent letters, homophones

Other scenarios/tasks

Entry Level 3 Task, New York New York, has similar questions and a different crossword puzzle.

Online tasks

These tasks can be completed instead of the worksheets in class. They can be shown to the whole class if individual computers are unavailable. They can also be used individually away from class by students.

More ideas and things to note

As an extension activity the students could design their own poster of a favourite holiday destination which contains information and an appropriate image. A discussion about copyright laws could also be included in the session as the students look for their image. They could also take images of signs around their community and then discuss the importance and relevance of their placement.
